WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

Current Year 11 or 12 students who are interested in a civil construction pathway and want to develop enterprise and employability skills to participate in a modern workplace while gaining practical skills.

To be eligible for selection students must be able to commit to training dates and have a learner's permit or provisional driver's licence. Preference will be given to doorways2construction students.

WHAT YOU CAN ACHIEVE

UP TO 20 STAGE TWO SACE CREDITS

Nationally accredited units form part of the **Certificate III in Civil Construction (RII30919)** qualification, designed to attract up to 20 SACE Stage Two credits and to set students up for post school success.

Students will receive a Statement of Attainment for units of competency achieved including:

- CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)
- RIIBEF201D Plan and organise work
- RIICCM205E Carry out manual excavation
- RIICCM207D Spread and compact materials manually
- RIISAM203D Use hand and power tools
- RIIWHS201D Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures.



PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

Students will benefit from practical 'hands-on' training at Civil Train's live training site at Burton.

Suitable students will also have access to work experience placements through Renewal SA's Works Program.

APPRENTICESHIPS

All students who successfully complete the Roads2Civil program will be considered for a civil apprenticeship.

W H A T ' S I N C L U D E D

Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE) required to participate safely.

WHEN AND WHERE

Students will complete three weeks of training between **20 September and 15 October 2021** within the City of PAE and at the Civil Train Live Works Site, Burton.

HO W TO APPLY

Interested students must register by **Monday, 19 July 2021** to attend a mandatory information session held on **Wednesday, 21 July 2021 5:30 – 7:30pm** at Civil Train, 1 South Road Thebarton where you will learn more about the program and meet the participating organisations. Following the information session attendees will then be invited to submit an application by **Wednesday**, **11 August 2021**.
