ABOUT THE COURSE

Stackable VET is a short course available to school students who have previously completed Certificate II in Engineering Pathways

Stackable VET courses aim to provide pre-vocational skills, work preparedness and the opportunity to extend skills and knowledge.

PATHWAYS

Western Technical College provides support to students to transition to work through the Western Technical College Industry Connect program.

Successful completion of this qualification may enable students to transition to work through an Australian School Based Apprenticeship (ASBA) or fully indentured apprenticeship.

COURSE LOCATION
