

INTRODUCTION TO HAIRDRESSING (STACKABLE VET 2022)

ABOUT THE COURSE

Stackable VET is a short course available to school students who are not engaged in a Flexible Industry Pathway. Stackable VET courses aim to provide pre-vocational skills, work preparedness and the opportunity to try out different vocational areas.

PATHWAYS

Western Technical College provides support to students to transition to work through the Western Technical College Industry Connect program.

Successful completion of this qualification may enable students to transition to work through an Australian School Based Apprenticeship (ASBA) or fully indentured apprenticeship.

COURSE LOCATION

Western Technical College is located at 44 Russell Street, Rosewater. Serviced by public transport (Bus and Train). Bus Stop 34 on Newcastle Street, Rosewater or Alberton Train Station (a 4-minute walk). Check Adelaide Metro for times and routes.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Students are to provide their own Personal Electronic Device / Computer (BYOD) and wear the following Personal Protective Equipment/Uniform:

- Black trousers (leisure wear is not permitted)
- Low heel black shoes.
